A 12 month fellowship in Clinical Epilepsy and EEG is available at the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital (RPAH), Sydney, commencing January 2012. RPAH is one of three Comprehensive Epilepsy Programs for adults in NSW and provides an opportunity for a wide experience in Clinical Epilepsy, inpatient and outpatient Electroencephalography, functional imaging with PET. The fellowship will also provide an opportunity to participate in research projects in EEG, clinical epilepsy and PET. The salary will be at a senior registrar rates (commensurate with experience).

The post is suitable for Neurology advanced trainees who wish to pursue a career in Epilepsy or to gain competency in Clinical Epilepsy and Electroencephalography. Successful candidates will hold a medical degree, FRACP part one exam and ideally have completed at least 12 months of neurology core training. The candidate should be able to work independently as well as within a team.
