

**13th CLINICAL NEUROPHYSIOLOGY WORKSHOP OF THE AUSTRALIAN AND

The next Clinical Neurophysiology Workshop will be held at the Sheraton Mirage Resort, October 4-7, 2009. Workshop registration will be on Sunday October 4 from noon - 2.00 pm.

The Workshop will include sessions on common clinical disorders, muscle disease, evoked responses, neuropathies, movement disorders and neuromuscular disease and include case presentations, scheduled as in the program. It is planned to have a session of free communications as posters.

As usual, the format will be relaxed and informal and conclude Wednesday afternoon when the usual "closing ceremony" will be held. The programme is enclosed.
