We require a full-time Consultant Neurologist for generalist neurology practice. Subspecialty expertise is an advantage, with subspecialty interest in neurophysiology being ideal. Applicants must have advanced training in Neurology and be eligible for vocational registration with the Medical Council of New Zealand. (For details see www.mcnz.org.nz). There is a full range of supporting services, including the South Island Regional service for Neurosurgery, MRI, CT and DSA/neurointervention facilities.
