



ANZAN-ASEPA EEG COURSE

Royal Melbourne Hospital
Monday 18th and Tuesday 19th October 2010

Course Aims: To provide a theoretical and practical background to the reading and reporting of routine EEG and to provide hands-on experience in the reading, optimal display and interpretation of normal and abnormal EEG.

Target Audience: Neurology trainees with and without experience in EEG. Neurologists wishing to refresh, update or enhance their skills in routine EEG. This year, the course will be held immediately before the Asian-Oceanian Epilepsy Congress and will be open to overseas delegates from the region.

Format: The course will be held over two days. There will be four sessions, each devoted to a major topic, on each day. Each session will begin with a lecture for 20-30 minutes, followed by a hands-on workshop lasting 50-60 minutes. Participants will break up into small groups, each with their own workstation, at which EEG samples will be demonstrated and discussed under the leadership of an instructor. Tutorial Groups will be graded according to experience.

Location: Conference Centre, Royal Melbourne Hospital, Parkville, Melbourne
